Firstly I would like to thank the GBBA for inviting me to judge and all the exhibitors we brought some wonderful dogs to go over – in several classes the depth of quality was very high and I was spoiled for choice. I was looking for the cobby bodies and large heads that are essential of correct breed type. I also where possible promoted good top lines and tail-set. In general temperaments were excellent but in the rough coats there was a wide variation of coat textures.

### **Veteran Dog or Bitch (9 entries) Abs 5**

1. Chapman's CH. LIAMFORD MISS JET – Black Rough bitch with an excellent head, lovely well shaped round eye, good nose placement, excellent ear set and carriage. Held her cobby outline both standing and moving. Strong neck, sturdy body and correct tail set. Once settled moved showing her self confidence and terrier like temperament. **BEST VETERAN**
2. Ogden's CH. BEAUVIEW OUT OF THE CLOSET - Black & Tan Rough male with excellent skull, well shaped eye and excellent nose placement and good lay-back. Excellent top-line, good body but would prefer a little more bone. Well angulated front and rear and moved well. Well mark and in lovely overall condition.

### **Puppy Dog (3/0)**

1. Hughes & Crawford's BEAUBORNE BRAVE GIACOMA – Black & Tan Smooth with well shaped skull, lovely dark round eye, excellent nose placement and good chin. Super cobby square outline with good top-line and tail set. Good bone and body for age. Took time to settle but once did, moved well with confidence and purpose. Excellent temperament. Well marked with excellent short coat. **BEST PUPPY DOG**
2. Suggitt's APTRICK STORMBRAVER – Black Smooth with excellent skull, good ear set and carriage, good muzzle & face profile. Strong neck with excellent top-line. Would prefer a little shorter in body. Excellent tail set. Moved well and good temperament.

### **Junior Dog (4/2)**

1. Suggitt's APTRICK STORMBRAVER
2. Martyn's DONZEATA ROYAL EXCHANGE – Red Rough with good eye, well shaped skull and good ear set. Would prefer strong under jaw and better nose placement. Strong neck leading on to excellent top line but tail set could be higher. Still immature in both mind and body, he was very erratic on the move but had a good outgoing temperament. Excellent coat texture

### **Novice Dog (2/0)**

1. Rundle's APPEGARTH CAN YOU BOOGIE – Black & Tan Rough with a lovely head, excellent eye, good nose placement, good mouth and chin, all combining to give the typical ape-like expression. Well balanced

outline with good top line, good tail set but carriage a little tight. Still maturing and needs more body and development in fore-chest. Moved well with purpose. Well marked and good harsh coat texture. Excellent temperament.

### **Limit Dog (5/2)**

1. Lee, Cooper & Seymour's MILLBONE GINGER BREAD – Red Rough with a handsome masculine head, excellent well defined skull, large dark round eyes, excellent nose placement with super lay-back. Neat lips covering a strong, defined chin, excellent ear set and carriage. Good top line and tail set but would prefer a looser carriage. Solid body with good chest and well sprung ribcage and good bone. In super overall condition with a harsh, well tailored coat which was presented to perfection. Excellent muscle tone. Move well with self assured confidence. Excellent temperament. **BEST MALE & BIS**

2. Smith's BEAUVIEW I CAN HEAR THUNDER – Black & Tan Smooth with well shaped head, excellent eye, good ear set, excellent nose placement and lovely expression. Solid outline with good bone but carrying a little extra weight which solid his top line on the move. Excellent tail set and carriage. Lovely outgoing temperament and moved well with a happy positive attitude.

### **Open Dog (5/3)**

1. Swinge's CH. BALTHAZAR DEVIL IN DISGUISE – Red rough with an excellent head, well shaped skull, good nose placement and lay-back. Excellent face profile with good mouth, good ear set and carriage. Would prefer slightly darker pigmentation. Super square cobby outline with good bone and substance for size. Good neck and top line with good tail set and carriage. Well angulated front and rear and moved well. Positive temperament. Good coat colour. **RES BEST MALE & RES BIS**

2. Thompson's CH. BEAUVIEW TROOP THE COLOUR – Black & tan with a lovely head, large dark round eye, excellent nose placement, well shaped skull and excellent ear set and carriage. Stocky body but would prefer a little more bone to balance his sturdiness. Well marked and in well tailored jacket. Texture could be a little harsher. Well developed forechest and well sprung. Good top line and tail set. Moved with confidence but would prefer more rear drive. Excellent temperament.

### **Minor Puppy (3/1)**

1. Price's MARQUANT SWEET DREAMS – Red Rough with lovely monkey-like expression, excellent ear set and carriage. Skull of sufficient size for age and well shaped. Excellent nose placement with super face profile. Study, cobby body with excellent top line, short backed and excellent tail set and carriage. Good rich clear colour and coat of wonderful texture. Well angulated front and rear and moved well holding her cobby shape. Excellent temperament. **BEST PUPPY BITCH & BEST PUPPY IN SHOW**

2. Ogden's BEAUVIEW MIRROR ON THE WALL – Red Smooth with pretty head, excellent nose placement, excellent ear set and carriage. Good neck and tail set but held top line a little high on the move. Colour clearing. Once settled moved well. Good positive temperament.

### **Puppy Bitch (3/1)**

1. Price's MARQUANT SWEET DREAMS (as above)

2. Ogden's BEAUVIEW SOME SUNNY DAY – Red Rough with excellent head, good skull, excellent nose placement & face profile, good chin. Well balanced outline stacked, excellent top line and tail set. Coat starting to texture up. Good body and excellent bone. Decided that today she did not want to move despite the best efforts of the handler. Confident if a little stubborn in temperament.

### **Junior Bitch (4/0)**

1. Woolford's APLEGARTH MAMA MIA – Black & Tan rough with an endearing head and expression, lovely dark round eye, excellent nose placement & face profile. Well shaped skull of good size, good mouth and well defined chin. Feminine outline but still cobby and sturdy with good fore chest and well sprung ribcage. Good top line but tail set could be a little higher. Super harsh coat textured. Her strong, determined temperament shone through on the move, showing off her lively terrier spirit.

2. Rose's RHODON REGAL MADAM – Red Smooth with good eye, well shaped skull, good face profile, good ear set and carriage. Good top line tail set but outline was a little long. Excellent bone and substance for size. Moved well. Excellent rich clear colour. Very good temperament.

### **Post Graduate (8/3)**

1. Swinge's BALTHAZAR ANGEL EYE – Red Smooth with well shaped eye, good ear set but would prefer them slightly smaller. Well placed nose with open nostril, good mouth and well developed chin. Good square outline with good bone substance. Excellent feet. Moved well with very positive, outgoing attitude. In lovely over all condition.
2. Simpson & Phillipson's NOSYGRIF YOU BELONG TO ME – Red Smooth with a very attractive head and bright, cheerful expression. Feminine outline with a square profile but would prefer a little more to bone. In lovely overall condition and moved well. Happy & positive temperament.
3. Hughes & Crawford's BEAUVIEW BARGAIN HUNT
4. Chandler's CHANDLING CHATTERING
5. Rose's RHODON MISS CHIEF

### **Limit (4/1)**

1. Thompson's BEAUVIEW JUST CANT HIDE IT – Red Smooth with well shaped skull of good size, good ear set and carriage and well place nose with good lay-back. Good mouth and chin. Excellent text-book outline with the correct proportioned giving a sturdy, solid, yet feminine outline. Excellent top line with good tail carriage. Excellent feet. Moved well with a smooth positive action. Excellent stable, self assured temperament. In lovely overly condition with a good coat of super rich colour. **RES BEST BITCH**
2. Spittle's RHODON REGAL MAID – Red Smooth with feminine head & expression. Small package but well proportioned for size. Good top line but would prefer a slightly higher tail set. Excellent spring of rib but would prefer a little more development in chest. Very attentive to her handler. Well balanced outline. Moved well when settled. Good temperament.

### **Open (5/1)**

1. Swinge's BALTHAZAR ROXANNE – Red Rough with a well appointed head, with good face profile, well shaped skull, good round eye, good nose placement and mouth. Well constructed with good front assembly, excellent top line, well sprung rib cage and firm rear, but would prefer a slightly shorter body. Excellent rich clear colour with coat of good texture. Outgoing temperament.
2. Ogden's CH. BEAUVIEW FLY THE FLAG – Black & Tan Rough with attractive head, excellent dark round eye, good ear set and excellent nose placement. Cobby outline with excellent top line and tail set. Well developed in fore chest and well sprung. Moved well but would prefer a little more rear drive. Well marked and in excellent jacket. Excellent temperament.
3. Rose's RHODON REGINA
4. Willsmer's CH. GAYSTOCK JUST SO

### **Special Open Red Dog or Bitch (5/2)**

1. Chandler's MENWINNION MOLINIA – Red Smooth with good skull, well shaped eye, good nose placement, ear set and size. Excellent strong neck, good top line and tail set. Outline was a little long but excellent bone and substance. Moved well. Very nice temperament.
2. Thompson's BEAUVIEW WITH A CHERRY ON TOP – Red Rough with excellent skull, good eye, excellent ear set and good nose placement. Outline was a little unbalance as carrying a little extra weight and would benefit for a slightly longer neck. Well sprung and good fore chest. Good front movement but would prefer a little more rear drive. Positive temperament.

### **Special Open Black & Tan Dog or Bitch (5/2)**

1. Donnellan's BEAUVIEW GIRLS NIGHT OUT – Black & Tan Smooth in tip-top condition. Very attractive head with captivating expression. Large, dark, round expressive eyes, good mouth and strong chin. Excellent ear set and carriage. Glamorous but cobby outline that was both sharp and structural with good bone, well developed chest & well sprung rib cage. Balance front and rear assembly which showed in her ability to move in a smooth positive action. Warm, endearing temperament added to her other virtues carried her through stiff competition to be awarded **BEST BITCH**
